

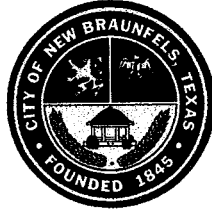

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens know and appreciate the duties and responsibilities of their Police Department, and that members of our Police Department recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, by protecting them against violence or disorder, and by protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression or intimidation; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of New Braunfels has become a modern and efficient law enforcement agency deserving of our community's unceasing pride and gratitude.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, R. BRUCE BOYER, Mayor of the City of New Braunfels, Texas, call upon all citizens of the City of New Braunfels and upon all patriotic, civil and educational organizations to observe the week of May 15th through May 21st, 2011 as
