District 1 Citizen Forum Features Capital Projects & AACOG

New Braunfels, Texas — On Tuesday, August 11th, beginning at 6:00 p.m., District 1 City Councilman George Green will host a Citizen Forum at Holy Family Catholic Church, 245 S. Hidalgo Avenue.

Featured at the forum will be a presentation by Bryan Woods, City of New Braunfels Capital Programs Manager. The Capital Programs Division was created to deliver capital projects to the citizens of New Braunfels. Projects include traditional "horizontal" projects such as street and drainage projects and "vertical" projects such as fire stations, parks facilities, etc.

Diane Rath, the Executive Director of the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG), will provide the second half of the program. AACOG is an association of local governments and organizations that serves its members through planning, information and coordination activities. It serves an area that covers 13 counties in south central Texas. The organization was created to enhance the quality of life of all residents in the region in partnership with elected and appointed officials and community partners.

“Come out and enjoy a bar-b-que chicken plate, or nachos, followed by discussions about current and future projects in District 1,” said Councilman Green. “Residents who travel Morningside Drive, Rueckle Road and Solms Road will certainly be interested in this update, which includes information on the plans for reconstruction of these roadways. I encourage District 1 residents, and all other citizens of New Braunfels, to join me for these informative presentations.”

Dinner, which is first-come, first-served, will start the meeting off at 6:00 p.m.
