Ghosthunting San Antonio, Austin, and Texas Hill Country Talk at the Library

New Braunfels, TX – Michael O. Varhola will speak about his book “Ghosthunting San Antonio, Austin, and Texas Hill Country” on Thursday, October 13th at 7:00 p.m. at the New Braunfels Public Library. The book is the latest in the popular America’s Haunted Road Trip Series.

“America's Haunted Road Trip is a series of haunted travel guides,” Toni Davenport, Adult Services Librarian said. “The author of each book visits inns, museums, cemeteries, theaters, and many other places interviewing people who live and work there. Also included are travel instructions, maps, and an appendix of many more locations that the reader can visit.”

Local author Michael O. Varhola drew upon his training and experiences as a historian, journalist, and paranormal investigator while compiling this colorful and useful guide to 30 publicly accessible haunted places in San Antonio and Austin as well as the Texas Hill Country. The guide fits visitor's needs, with a combination of Texas history, haunted lore, phenomena, and practical travel information.
