Neighborhood Meeting and Groundbreaking Set for Klein Road Improvements Project

New Braunfels, Texas — The public is invited to attend a groundbreaking ceremony for the 2013 Bond Program Proposition 1 project addressing roadway improvements on Klein Road. The event will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 17th at the Klein Road/2620 Klein Way entrance to Klein Elementary School.

Residents living in the vicinity of the project are encouraged to attend a neighborhood public meeting scheduled for Thursday, May 10th at 6:30 p.m., at Klein Road Elementary School, to learn about the project and have their questions addressed.

The initiative will widen the roadways to two travel lanes each way (from New Braunfels Middle School to S. Walnut Avenue), with a left-hand turn lane between them on certain segments of the project, as well as dedicated left and right-hand turn lanes at major intersections. The segment from FM 1044 to New Braunfels Middle school will have one travel lane each direction. The overall project will also include a ten-foot shared use path (for pedestrians, bikes, etc.) on both sides, adjacent to the street. The intersection at FM 1044 will be re-aligned for improved turning maneuvers. Additionally, street curbs will be installed on both sides of the roadways and all driveways will be replaced with concrete aprons to the right-of-way line.

This project is budgeted at \$8 million and the timeline anticipates a two-year completion, pending weather and other factors, with construction underway in June of 2018.
