Kerlick Avenue Park Community Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels is inviting the public to participate in a community meeting regarding a possible Kerlick Avenue Park project as part of the potential 2019 Bond Program. The meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 5th, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., at the New Braunfels Christian Academy, 995 Mission Hills Drive.

City Council recently approved the preliminary engineering contracts for multiple proposed 2019 Bond Program projects, including the Kerlick Avenue Park. The preliminary design contract for the potential project was awarded to Rialto Studio. The preliminary design will assist the City Council in identifying project feasibility for the proposed 2019 Bond Program.

This first meeting will provide the community with an opportunity to review options for the Kerlick Avenue Park. All interested individuals, organizations and businesses from New Braunfels are encouraged to attend, learn about the potential project, and offer input.
