Downtown Sidewalks Improvements Ribbon Cutting Set

New Braunfels, Texas — The City of New Braunfels invites the public to attend a ribbon cutting celebrating the completion of the downtown sidewalks improvement project. The ceremony will be held at 8:30 a.m. in front of the Brauntex Performing Arts Theatre on Thursday, September 27th. Parking is available behind the theatre.

The City's Downtown Implementation Plan, completed in 2009, identified "circulation, walkability and aesthetics" along with "pedestrian infrastructure" as critical factors, essential to the future economic success of downtown.

The sidewalk improvements project creates a continuous ADA accessible path throughout the project limits and unifies the aesthetics of the corridor by incorporating brick pavers and extending the stylized lighting on San Antonio Street. In addition to the ADA path, the project includes pedestrian signals at the intersections of Castell Avenue and Academy Avenue at San Antonio Street.

The project was funded by the City of New Braunfels and the New Braunfels Economic Development Corp.
