Library Adds TumbleMath to List of Digital Resources

New Braunfels, TX — TumbleMath, an extension of the digital resource TumbleBooks, is now available to New Braunfels Public Library cardholders.

“TumbleBooks is one of our most popular databases, and we were excited when they developed a resource that focused on math,” said Youth Services Librarian Jenny Rodriguez. “TumbleMath offers picture books on a variety of reading levels that cover multiple mathematical concepts including addition, subtraction, multiplication, probability, geometry, measurement, fractions and more.”

According to its website, TumbleMath has the most comprehensive collection of math stories available anywhere — all in its world-famous TumbleBook format, which combines animation, narration and sound to create a “compelling and enticing” storybook for students of all ages. The books are accompanied by supplementary materials including lesson plans, instructional videos, educational games and quizzes.
