4th of July Hours at City Facilities

New Braunfels, Texas — Most City of New Braunfels facilities, including City Hall, the Library, Landa Park Recreation Center and Administrative offices, Fischer Park Nature Center, the Municipal Building and the Westside Community Center will be closed on Thursday, July 4th in observation of our nation's Independence Day.

Solid waste and recycling services (garbage, recycling, and green waste pickup) will occur as normally scheduled.

Das Rec, the New Braunfels Recreation Center will have modified hours - open from 8AM – 5PM.

Landa Park attractions will be open as follows:

- Landa Park Boathouse – open from 12PM - 7PM
- Landa Park Mini-Golf Course – open from 10AM – 7PM

- City Tube Chute at Prince Solms Park – open from 10AM – 7PM

The Landa Park Golf Course at Comal Springs is hosting the Firecracker Open Tournament that day but will open to public pre-seating for the HEB Fireworks Spectacular at 6PM.
