Westside Community Center's Krueger Avenue Entrance Closed Wednesday, Thursday

New Braunfels, TX — The installation of new fire exits at the Westside Community Center is approaching 50 percent completion, but with that progress comes new closures.

The Krueger Avenue entrance to the center will be closed Wednesday and Thursday, Oct. 16th and 17th, due to the staging of the equipment necessary for the demolition of the second fire exit stairwell. Parking on that side of the building will be closed until work for the day is complete, around 5:00 p.m.

“We’re taking safety precautions to ensure the safety of our patrons,” said Outreach Coordinator Jennifer Hernandez. “Additionally, the main entrance to the community center will remain closed the entire time this phase of the project is underway. Patrons should plan to enter through the gym doors from Wednesday, Oct. 16th, through Friday, Oct. 25th.”

The Krueger Avenue entrance will reopen on Friday for the Mobile Food Pantry and on Saturday for Zumbathon.

On Monday and Tuesday, Oct. 21st and 22nd, the Krueger Avenue entrance will close again, as will the parking area on that side of the building.

“They will be welding on those days next week, which could be hazardous to anyone walking or parking on that side of the community center,” said Hernandez. “The hope is that they will be done with welding by the end of day Tuesday, at which time we can reopen the Krueger entrance and the parking lot on that side.”

The fire exits at the Westside Community Center are being renovated through Community Development Block Grant funding.
