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Traffic Advisory:
Bridge Caps for East San Antonio Street Bridge Being Delivered This Week

New Braunfels, Texas — In an effort to expedite the ongoing reconstruction of the East San Antonio Street Bridge, Capital Excavation, the contractor on the project, will be using large pre-cast bridge caps that will be placed on top of the bridge's support columns. These large pieces will be delivered on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of this week, which may cause some delays for drivers in the immediate area.

On Wednesday and Thursday, drivers can expect several of those pieces to arrive in the area around 11am. The trucks carrying those large pieces will make their way from I-35, down Loop 337 to Common Street, then into the parking lot of Prince Solms Park. Minimal traffic delays are expected with these deliveries.

On Friday, between 11am and 12pm, more of those structures will be delivered to the other side of the bridge, which will cause temporary but significant traffic delays. The truck will exit I-35 and turn onto South Seguin Ave. before partially turning onto the Main Plaza traffic circle. The truck will then back up into East San Antonio St. toward the bridge. This maneuver will impact traffic around the Main Plaza and East San Antonio Street for approximately 30 minutes, with traffic control officers provided by the New Braunfels Police Department.

The times for the arrival of these structures are approximate and may be subject to traffic delays or changes due to weather. Drivers are urged to avoid those areas if possible, and to have patience if they find themselves temporarily affected by traffic.

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
