- Using the webpage, you can accurately complete your registration online and receive a confirmation email for yourself or your employer records.

FOOD HANDLER

- All full & part time employees, including management, and owners must obtain a food handlers certificate.
- You can take our in-house food handler course (See schedule above).
- You will be automatically registered.**

CERTIFIED FOOD MANAGER (CFM)

- At least **one person, per establishment who is working directly with food**, is required to obtain a Food Manager's certification.
- If you have a Food Manager's certification **you will need to register** it with our office, but no fee will be assessed.
- You will not need a food handler certificate if you have a Food Manager's Certification.
