

Contribution to Central Texas Technology Center Expansion

Project Description

This project calls for expanding the current size of the Central Texas Technology Center (CTTC), effectively doubling its current footprint to add capacity and enroll additional students. This project would implement post-secondary education recommendations set forth in the 2010 Mayor’s Higher Education Task Force report and the 2012 Economic Development Strategic Plan. There are approximately 2,000 students at the current facility. The school provides services to five area school districts and regional industries. The proposed amount of \$4 million would only fund a portion of the estimated \$6.3 million expansion and implementation of the project. The issuance of bonds depends upon securing other community and/or federal or state funds.
