

Dry Comal Hike & Bike Trail Improvements/ Extension

Project Description

This project provides connection of the existing Dry Comal Trail to Landa Park and the downtown area. It will increase pedestrian mobility to the west side of New Braunfels as well as provide a natural area for outdoor activities and exercise. This project will extend the Dry Comal Trail that borders the Loop 337 baseball fields along the Dry Comal Creek. The completed trail will follow the Dry Comal Creek from the existing trail to an intersection with the Walnut Avenue Trail and continue on the Town Creek Trail (a proposed connection) to Landa Park and downtown. Improvements to the current trail loop at the baseball fields could also be made.
