Holocaust Survivor Speaking at the Westside Community Center

New Braunfels, TX - Inge Auerbacher, who survived imprisonment at the Terezin Concentration Camp in the former Czechoslovakia during World War II, will discuss her wartime experiences on Wednesday, May 20th at 7 p.m. at the Westside Community Center. In 1986, Auerbacher published a book about her childhood experiences entitled *I am a Star: Child of the Holocaust*.
