### **Heavy Rains Force Temporary Closure of Comal River**

New Braunfels, Texas — Due to heavy rains, the Comal River in New Braunfels is now closed to recreation for the remainder of the day today (Saturday, June 20, 2015).

River conditions will be reevaluated Sunday morning (June 21, 2015). At that time, a determination will be made about whether recreation can resume. Another press release will be sent once that determination is made.

The Guadalupe River in New Braunfels is currently flowing at over 5400 cfs and remains closed to tubing. Only rafting and kayaking is allowed, and guided rafting trips through local river outfitters are highly advised.
