## **Councilmember Monceballez Hosting District 4 Citizen Forum**

**New Braunfels, Texas** — On Tuesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 6:00 p.m., Councilmember Chris Monceballez will host his first Citizen Forum. This public meeting will be held in the conference room of the New Braunfels Public Library, beginning at 6:00 p.m. The library is located at 700 E. Common Street.

Comal County representatives will kick off the forum by discussing the November 3rd bond election for a proposed new jail facility and sheriff's office.

Members of the Friends of the New Braunfels Independent School District (NBISD) will then provide information on the proposed items on the NBISD bond election, also slated for November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

“City of New Braunfels Public Works Director Steve Ramsey and Capital Programs Manager Bryan Woods will also lead a discussion on the Public Works department, as well as projects either completed or in the works for the District 4 and city-wide,” said Councilmember Chris Monceballez. “As we approach nearly five years to the day when district meetings were held after the high water events of 2010, we will discuss what the city has accomplished since those meetings as well as initiatives currently underway and future projects in development regarding drainage. City Manager Robert Camareno and I will also be on hand to answer questions.”
