Information Seminar Scheduled on Trap Neuter Return Program

New Braunfels, TX - The New Braunfels Community Cat Coalition, the San Antonio Feral Cat Coalition and the New Braunfels Public Library will offer an information seminar for all who are interested in learning more about the Trap Neuter Return (TNR) program and how it can work to counter the over-population of outdoor cats in our community. The session will be held on Sunday, September 20th at the New Braunfels Public Library, 700 E. Common St., New Braunfels, TX 78130 at 2:00 p.m. in the library meeting room.

City ordinances allow residents to use TNR methods to control the unchecked proliferation of community cats. The Coalitions and the Humane Society of New Braunfels are the organizations that are working with the City to ensure that residents have the training and resources to work with community - or feral - cats effectively and safely.

“The San Antonio Feral Cat Coalition has been a pioneer in working with all the partners in a community to control community cats. Since this is still a new concept to many of our city residents, their expertise has been invaluable in helping local citizens develop a program of their own through the New Braunfels Community Cat Coalition. We hope that many residents will attend and learn more about this proven method to reduce outdoor cat populations.” said Library Director Gretchen Pruett.
