Assault at NBHS Band Practice

New Braunfels, Texas — The New Braunfels Police Department is investigating following a reported Assault Causing Bodily Injury that occurred during Tuesday afternoon's New Braunfels High School band practice at the school (in the 2500 block of Loop 337).

Students and faculty participating in afternoon band practice on September 22nd, 2015, reported hearing a series of pops. A few moments later, two students complained of being struck by objects that they believed to be from a BB or pellet gun. The students, ages 16 and 17, suffered minor injuries and no medical attention was required. However, New Braunfels Police and the New Braunfels ISD take such an incident very seriously.

NBISD officials are notifying parents of band members about the incident, and NBPD will have an increased presence at band practices in the coming days. NBPD detectives are also actively investigating this case and following up on all leads.
