Tips Sought in Aggravated Robbery Investigation

New Braunfels, Texas — The New Braunfels Police Department is currently looking for tips from the public about the identity of an aggravated robbery suspect. The robbery occurred at the New Braunfels Wal-Mart location in the 1200 block of I-35 South around 3am on September 29, 2015. Officers were called to the scene after the suspect fled from the store on foot. A search of the area was unsuccessful in locating the suspect. He is described as a white, possibly Hispanic, male. He was clean shaven, wearing black shorts and a red t-shirt. During the robbery, the suspect displayed what appeared to be a firearm and threatened employees with bodily harm if they continued to follow him.

New Braunfels Police investigators are seeking tips from the public about the identity of the suspect. Attached are three store surveillance images of the suspect.
