Tips Sought in ID Theft (Credit Card/Debit Card Abuse) Case

New Braunfels, Texas — The New Braunfels Police Department is seeking tips from the public on the identities of two suspects believed to have used stolen credit card/debit card information.

The victim's card was last used legitimately on Saturday Oct. 10, 2015, at retail establishments in New Braunfels and Seguin. A little more than a week later, on Oct. 18, 2015, the stolen information was used at the New Braunfels Wal-Mart location (in the 2900 block of I-35 South). Video surveillance cameras captured images of the suspects as they left the store after making hundreds of dollars worth of fraudulent purchases.

The first suspect is described as a Hispanic male standing approximately 5-feet 10-inches to 6-feet tall, wearing white cargo shorts, a light-orange or salmon-colored t-shirt, a blue ball cap, and red shoes. The second suspect is described as a white male with a muscular build standing approximately 5-feet 8-inches tall, weighing approximately 160-pounds, wearing khaki shorts, a blue and white striped polo-style shirt, with dark close-cropped hair. (Photos of suspects attached) The two suspects were last seen leaving the Wal-Mart parking lot together in a gray Hummer.

Anyone with information on the identities of these suspects is asked to call New Braunfels Police or Crime Stoppers. Comal County Crime Stoppers is offering a reward of up to \$2000 for information that leads to an arrest and/or grand jury indictment.
