Night Court and Free Occupational Driver's License Legal Clinic Scheduled

New Braunfels, Texas — On January 13th, from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., New Braunfels is conducting night court. In addition, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. that same night, four attorneys—Jennifer Dillingham (from the Law Office of Frank Suhr), Wade Arledge (from the Law Office of Wade Arledge), Julie Vela (from the Law Office of Julie Vela), and Jennifer Gonzales (from the Law Office of Susan Schoon)—have volunteered to provide a free Occupational Driver's License Legal Clinic for those who have had their license suspended. This event will be held in the court offices at 1486 S. Seguin Avenue.

Night court is an opportunity for defendants to take care of their court business without having to take time off from work or to take care of cases already in warrant. Defendants may appear for night court if:

- They have a court appearance scheduled on or after the 13th of January;
- They have a case in warrants; and
- They contact the court at 830-221-4194 to schedule an appearance.

Defendants need to bring with them identification, a copy of motor vehicle insurance and any other documents that they wish to present to the court.

Defendants wanting to take advantage of the free occupational driver's license legal clinic must do the following:

- Prior to scheduling an appointment, defendants must obtain and complete an application that shows that the defendant qualifies for free legal services. Copies of the application are available in the Municipal Court lobby.
- Obtain a copy of their driver's license record (Type AR; cost \$20) from the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS). For copy of record, go on-line to www.Texas.gov; and
- Bring with them all of the paperwork sent to them by DPS regarding their suspension.
