Throughout the month of January, 2016 the library has classes on the basics of smart devices, with time at the end of each session to ask questions.

Many of the library's newest services are available for these devices, but the initial setup can be a little daunting. Each device also has its own specific protocols, so providing a simple instruction manual is not always possible. But library staff members have some expertise with most devices and operating systems, and can be a great resource. Attendees are encouraged to bring their equipment with them and should know their passwords for their main email account and any other services they may want to use, such as Amazon.
