Selma, Lord, Selma is being shown in conjunction with the first Annual MLK March which will be held on January 18th in New Braunfels, beginning at 10:00 a.m. at Prince Solms Park. The film tells the story of an 11 year-old girl who, inspired by a speech by Martin Luther King, Jr., joins the civil rights march from Selma to Montgomery, Alabama.
