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Be One of the First to Tour the future Mission Hill Park Property

New Braunfels – The City of New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department invites residents to a ‘walk about’ of the Mission Hill Park property on Saturday, March 19th from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Located at 2100 Independence Drive, adjacent to the WestPoint Village shopping center, this 10 acre natural area features wooded and open areas and magnificent views of the city and surrounding area. The land was dedicated to the New Braunfels Park Foundation in 2012 and a contract with Schrickel, Rollins and Associates for development of a Master Plan was approved by City Council in January 2016.

“We are excited to take this first step in the process of gathering public opinions on the development of this property,” said Stacey Dicke, Director of Parks and Recreation. “It’s a wonderful opportunity for the community to preview the raw land and consider their ideas and suggestions prior to our first community input meeting which is scheduled for March 22nd.”

Please note that the walk will be over uneven, unpaved ground in a hill setting, participants should wear comfortable walking shoes. Parking will be available in Elan Westpointe’s back parking lot located at 2140 Independence Drive.

The first Mission Hill Park property community input meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 22nd at 6:30 p.m. in the cafeteria at Oak Run Middle School, located at 415 Oak Run Point. This event will be the first of several open forum meetings on the project. The meeting will be an opportunity for expressing ideas for the future development and preservation of Mission Hill Park.
