**Guadalupe River Bridge in Gruene Closed Temporarily**

**New Braunfels, Texas** — Due to high river flows and continuing storms in the area, the Guadalupe River Bridge in Gruene is closed until further notice. City crews and public safety officials are monitoring low water crossings and encourage everyone to “Turn Around – Don’t Drown.” The City provides an online road closure map at [www.nbtexas.org/roadclosuremap](http://www.nbtexas.org/roadclosuremap). Do not drive around barricades, it’s against the law and dangerous.

The area is also under a Flood Advisory until 5:45 PM, due to saturated soils, heavy rainstorms and runoff conditions. A Flash Flood Watch is in effect for all of South Central Texas through Thursday morning. Heavy rainfall will likely lead to an increasing flash flood threat across all of South-Central Texas through at least Thursday morning, according to the National Weather Service. Heightened awareness from all South Central Texas residents and is very important, particularly in low-lying areas. Citizens and visitors should monitor changing weather conditions through local media outlets.
