Landa Park and Arboretum Master Plan Community Input Meeting

New Braunfels, Texas – The New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department invites the public to share input regarding the Landa Park and Arboretum Master Plan. The community meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 26th from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. at Landa Haus, located at 360 Aquatic Circle. This event will be the second of several open forum meetings on the project.

Representatives from the Master Plan design team, Asakura Robinson, will start the meeting with a short presentation on the data collection they have done thus far, followed by an interactive session where the public can provide input relating to specific areas of the park. City staff will also be available during the meeting to answer questions and discuss the project.

"Input from residents is an important component in this process," explained Stacey Dicke, Director of Parks and Recreation. "We have an exceptional team of professionals working to create a vision for the future of Landa Park, and encourage all interested parties to bring suggestions or attend to learn more about the process."

The design team will work to develop the plan through October of 2016 using a multi-faceted strategy, including collaboration with the Master Plan Steering Committee, a stakeholder group and the general public.

Among other areas that will be addressed during the process are key concerns outlined in the adopted 2010 New Braunfels Strategic Parks and Recreation Master Plan such as improving wayfinding signage, arboretum tree health and preservation, traffic and pedestrian safety and circulation, parking, and refurbishment of key structures and facilities.
