Freud: Religion, Philosophy and Science at the Library

New Braunfels, TX – Mark Andrew Holowchak, PhD., will speak about Sigmund Freud on Thursday, September 22nd at 7:00 p.m. at the New Braunfels Public Library. The discussion is titled “A Utopian Vision: Freud and Religion, Philosophy, and Science.”

Dr. Holowchak’s presentation is based on his years of research and coursework on Freud. He has served as Assistant Professor at several colleges teaching a wide range of courses including courses on Freud as well as Ancient Philosophy, Greek & Roman Ethics, Environmental Ethics, Philosophy of Technology, Societal Philosophy and World Religions. He has multiple Master’s degrees in Philosophy and History of Science, Philosophy and Psychology. He also has a Doctorate in Philosophy and the History of Science. Holowchak has over a dozen published books and a wealth of scholarly articles ranging in topics from Thomas Jefferson’s philosophical ideals to sports fans.
