**Comal County Active Threat Response Exercise Scheduled**

**New Braunfels, Texas** —The Comal County Active Threat Response Committee is conducting an active shooter exercise on Monday, March 13<sup>th</sup> at Canyon High School. The committee is comprised of members of the New Braunfels Fire Department, New Braunfels Police Department, Comal County Sheriff's Office, New Braunfels ISD, Comal ISD, all of the Comal County Fire and EMS Departments, Garden Ridge Police Department, Bulverde Police Department and Schertz EMS.

Canyon High School will be secured and public will not be allowed onto the property during the duration of the exercise, which has been scheduled during the school district's spring break. The public may see emergency vehicles and first responders from the surrounding area on the campus with their emergency lights activated in an effort to make the exercise as lifelike as possible. The exercise will test the response and communication capabilities of the area's first responders and is set to start at approximately 9:30 a.m. and concluded around 11:30 a.m.
