12th Annual Flashlight Egg Hunt this Weekend

New Braunfels, TX - The City of New Braunfels Parks & Recreation Department is hosting their twelfth annual Flashlight Egg Hunt at Cypress Bend Park on Saturday, April 1st.

Check-in will start at 7:15 p.m. and the first hunt will begin at 7:45 p.m. Pre-registration is highly recommended. The fee is \$7 per hunter during pre-registration and \$10 per hunter the day of the event. Each hunter should bring their own flashlight and bag or basket. In addition to thousands of eggs filled with treats, there will also be prizes given to children who find "golden eggs" during the egg hunt.

"We will have hunts for different age groups - 2 to 3, 4 to 5, 6 to 7 and 8 to 11 - starting with the youngest and working our way to the oldest group," said Constance Favaro, Recreation Programs Supervisor. "There will be carnival games for participants to enjoy while they wait for their age group to be called and, of course, the Easter Bunny will make an appearance for photo opportunities."
