Comal and Guadalupe Rivers (in New Braunfels) Open for Recreation

New Braunfels, Texas — The temporary closure of the Comal River and the Guadalupe River in New Braunfels has been lifted by the Chief of Police and both rivers are now open for recreation.

The current flow of the Comal River is approximately 300cfs and the current flow of the Guadalupe River is approximately 287cfs.

Minor amounts of debris have been cleaned up and there were no major damages to city facilities following recent heavy rains.

River-goers should be aware of potentially submerged debris and should always use caution when on area waterways. And NBPD advises that everyone wear a life jacket when participating in water recreation.
