## Request for Tree Debris Pickup Deadline

**New Braunfels, Texas** — Requests from residents regarding pickup for tree debris related to Hurricane Harvey must be made by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 5, 2017.

Brush debris removal is scheduled to start on Thursday, August 31<sup>st</sup> and all requests made before September 5<sup>th</sup> will receive tree debris collection service. Requests made after September 5<sup>th</sup> will be treated as routine and any agreed upon service will be charged per the Solid Waste Ordinance. Residents can contact the City's Solid Waste and Recycling Division at 830-221-4040.

This call-in service is intended for residents with large tree trunks and high volumes of brush; it is best to place smaller limbs and small amounts of brush at the curb for regular, weekly Green Waste collection.
