Train vs Pedestrian Accident

New Braunfels, Texas — On today's date (02-23-18) at approximately 2:45am, officers with the New Braunfels Police Department and paramedics with the New Braunfels Fire Department were called to the 500 block of North Hidalgo Avenue for reports of a train vs pedestrian accident.

First responders arrived in the area and found a male suffering from critical, life-threatening injuries lying near the railroad tracks. Paramedics immediately began life-saving measures and transported the male to the San Antonio Military Medical Center (SAMMC) by ground EMS.

At this time, investigators have been unable to verify the man's identity. He is described as a Hispanic male in his 40's with dark short hair. He is approximately 5-feet 7-inches tall with a medium build. The unidentified man also has a number of tattoos on his body, including:

- a tattoo of a female wearing a sombrero with the name "Lisa" on his left arm (see photo)
- a tattoo of a skull with a flaming mohawk on his right chest
- a tattoo of a large cross on his stomach
- a tattoo of two hearts connected by banners on his right arm (with two illegible names written in the banners)
