It will detail county needs and policy priorities now and into the future. A huge component of the report will be based on community input. The plan will ultimately help county officials and leaders direct efforts and resources towards projects and initiatives which align with the community’s goals and vision for the future.

They are asking residents to fill out their community survey and to attend either of the two town halls; one will be held at the Seguin City Coliseum on June 20th and the other at the Schertz Civic Center on June 27th, both from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm.
