Library Adds Thousands of Digital Titles with cloudLibrary

New Braunfels, TX — The number of digital items available to check out from the New Braunfels Public Library has grown by over 100,000 titles with the addition of the cloudLibrary database, which provides digital access to eBooks and eAudiobooks from more than 25 other libraries in Texas.

“CloudLibrary is similar to Overdrive in that it offers eBooks and eAudiobooks, but cloudLibrary has many more options and newer titles — including best-sellers, Bluebonnet books and popular young adult titles — and is compatible with more mobile devices,” said Digital Services Librarian Miranda Robbins. “It’s also pretty intuitive and user friendly.”

The database is available on desktop computers and many eReading devices, including iOS and Android phones and tablets.

CloudLibrary users can customize their digital browsing experience using filters to sort titles by publication date, author, title, recent additions, or rating. CloudLibrary also offers one-click borrowing, meaning downloading a title is a single-step process. Users can borrow up to 10 items at a time, and cloudLibrary keeps all your content in sync across devices.

All that’s needed to access cloudLibrary is a New Braunfels Public Library card. For more information about cloudLibrary, call the library at 830-221-4300, or stop in and speak with library staff.
