**New Braunfels, TX** – For the first time New Braunfels residents will take to the streets of W. San Antonio and Spur Streets by bike, stroller, rollerblades, skateboards or by foot for CycloVIVA! The city-wide event, which takes place this Sunday, March 3rd, from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m., will feature numerous fitness and community education activities located at one of the three activity hubs – Culture & Heritage, Mobility, and Family & Health.

The event will include free fitness classes from Das Rec and Camp Gladiator, yoga, a rock-climbing wall and an obstacle course for kids. Texas A&M Comal County Extension will be blending smoothies by pedal power, RIOMobile will be out to provide library cards, and Chef Mario from Comal and New Braunfels ISD will be doing a healthy food demonstration.
