Train vs Pedestrian - Fatality

New Braunfels, Texas – On May 29, 2019, at approximately 8:42pm, the New Braunfels Police Department and the New Braunfels Fire Department were dispatched to the 600 block of Hill Ave for reports of a train vs a pedestrian incident.

Once on scene, officers observed an Amtrak commuter train that was en route to San Antonio had struck a young adult female who appeared to be laying on the tracks. The female was identified as 22-year-old Carrigan Georg of New Braunfels and was pronounced deceased on scene by New Braunfels Fire Department paramedics as well as the Justice of the Peace, Comal County Precinct #3. All rail traffic was stopped for approximately 2.5 hours while the investigation was completed by the New Braunfels Police Department and Union Pacific Railroad Police Department. Next of kin has been notified as of the writing of this release. The investigation into the incident will be handled by Union Pacific Railroad Police.
