RIOMobile Returns to Full Service

New Braunfels, TX — The RIOMobile is back on the streets of New Braunfels and boasting a refreshed collection of materials.

“We changed out the whole collection and adjusted the layout to better reflect what our patrons are checking out,” said Outreach Librarian Jonathan Margheim, who heads the RIOMobile program. “So, while being out of service was not ideal, it gave us the chance to improve on what we offer our patrons.”

The RIOMobile’s collection has also been entirely fitted with RFID stickers as part of the New Braunfels Public Library’s RFID upgrade. RFID, which stands for radio frequency identification, is a technology that uses various electronic devices to simplify library processes, including check-in and check-out.

The New Braunfels Public Library Foundation raised funds for the RIOMobile — which gets its name from the phrase “Reading and Inspiration through Outreach” — in 2015, with the goal of providing books and other library materials to children, seniors and those with limited mobility who might otherwise not be able to visit the main library facility.
