**Release Update**

The Texas Department of State Health Services made Guadalupe County Emergency Management aware that during their investigation, one of the patients who tested positive visited a local business within Guadalupe County. The Texas Department of State Health Services is supporting Guadalupe County in identifying any close contacts of the patient while sick, so they can be isolated and monitored for symptoms and quickly tested if needed.

It is possible that individuals who visited the following locations at the dates and times listed may have been exposed:

- March 21<sup>st</sup>, 9am-12pm: Walmart 6102 FM 3009 Schertz, TX 78154
- March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 9am-12pm: Walmart 6102 FM 3009 Schertz, TX 78154
- March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 9am-12pm: Walmart 6102 FM 3009 Schertz, TX 78154
- March 24<sup>th</sup>, 9am-12pm: Walmart 6102 FM 3009 Schertz, TX 78154

The risk of contracting the virus from these exposures is low, and isolation is not required for anyone that does not have symptoms. If you believe you have been exposed, monitor yourself carefully for symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath for 14 days after the exposure. If you experience any of these symptoms and do not need urgent medical attention, isolate at home, and contact your healthcare provider.
