

# COMAL RIVER RULES & REGULATIONS

- o A \$2 (non-refundable) River Management Fee is assessed to non-residents.
  - Residents may obtain a Resident River Season Pass to by-pass the fee.
- o No disposable containers
- o No glass
- o No foam containers
- o No littering
- o Life jackets are recommended for weak swimmers and children.
- o No volume drinking devices
- o No containers under 5 fluid oz.
- o Noise devices may not be audible beyond 50 feet
- o No jumping from bridges, dams, or trees
- o Coolers must have a locking mechanism on the lid (zipper, Velcro, latch, cord) with a maximum size of 30 quarts and 1 cooler per person
- o Vessels on the rivers may not be over 18 feet in length
- o Limit of two tubes per person
- o Canoes and kayaks may not use the Last Tubers Exit on the Comal River on weekends and holidays
- o Round inflatable flotation devices shall not exceed five feet (5') in diameter
